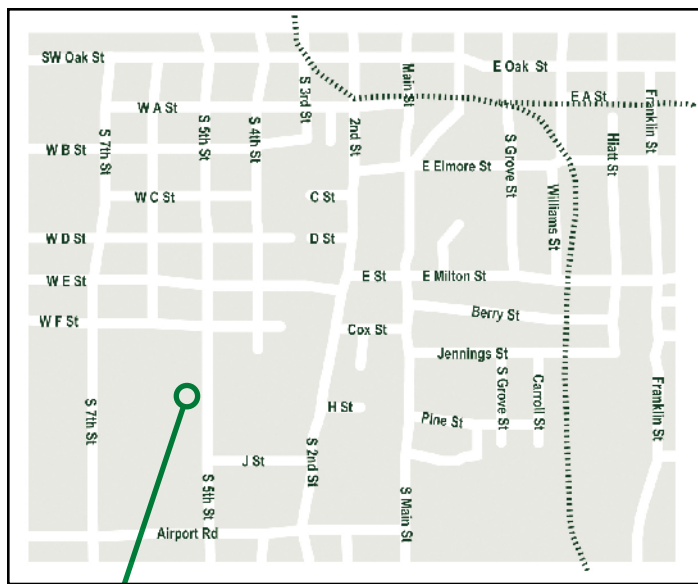

Please ride with consideration for your fellow riders.

Sag Course closes at 5:00 P.M. Riders still out will be given an opportunity to ride the sag back. If they decline, they will be on their own.

Release and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk & Indemnity Agreement

In consideration of being permitted to participate in any way in Santiam Spokes, Inc. sponsored bicycling activities by signing below, I for myself, my personal representatives, assigns, heirs, & next of kin:

1. — acknowledge, agree, and represent that I understand the nature of bicycling activities and that I am qualified to participate in such bicycling activity. I further acknowledge that the activity will be conducted over public roads and facilities open to the public during the activity and upon which the hazards of traveling are to be expected. I further agree and warrant that if at any time I believe conditions to be unsafe, I will immediately discontinue further participation in the activity.

2. — fully understand that: (a) bicycling involves risks and dangers of serious bodily injury, including permanent disability, paralysis and death; (b) these risks and dangers may be caused by my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating, the actions or inactions of the general public, the conditions under which the activity takes place, the negligence of the club or its officers, or the negligence of the releasees named nearby; (c) there may be other risks and social and economic losses either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time; and I fully accept and assume all such risks and all responsibility for losses, costs, damages and injury I incur as a result of my participation in the activity.

3. — hereby release, discharge, covenant not to sue, and agree to indemnify and save and hold harmless the Santiam Spokes, Inc. bicycling club, its respective administrators, directors, agents, and employees, other participants, any sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises on which the activity takes place, (each considered one of the "Releasees" herein) from all liability, claims, demands, losses, injury, or damages on my account or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the Releasees or otherwise, including negligent rescue operations; and I further agree that if, despite this Release and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement I, or anyone on my behalf, makes a claim against any of the Releasees", I will indemnify, save and hold harmless each of the Releasees from any litigation expenses, attorney fees, loss, liability, damage, or cost which any may incur as a result of such claim.

4. — agree to cycle in a safe, courteous, and lawful manner when participating in this event.

I have read this agreement; I fully understand its terms; I understand that I have given up substantial rights by signing it; and have signed it freely and without inducement or assurance of any nature and intend it to be a complete and unconditional release of all liability to the greatest

extent allowed by law and agree that if any portion of this agreement is held to be invalid, the balance shall continue in full force and effect.
